

### MARGUERITE VANN ETHNICITY 2017-2018



### MARGUERITE VANN School Action Plan Goal #1

#### Area of Concern:

• Based on the 2017-2018 test data, Marguerite Vann 3<sup>rd</sup> graders scored 28% in the 'Ready' category. 4<sup>th</sup> graders scored 42% 'Ready.'

#### Goal:

• We will use a system of academic and behavior supports and have a goal of each classroom teacher 'moving' 3-5 students up to the next level on the ACT Aspire test and NWEA assessment.
