## Math

Students will be reviewing test taking strategies in preparation for the ACT Aspire. Skills will include addition, subtraction, and/or multiplication.

Example: Mr. Johnson bought 20 boxes of oatmeal. Each box had 8 individual packages of oatmeal. What was the total number of individual packages of oatmeal Mr. Johnson bought?

Also, we will be reviewing multiplication and division of larger numbers.

Examples:

$$3,489 \times 4 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$468 \div 4 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

## Reading

Students have started reading myths from around the world. They will use the myths to review major reading topics, such as: character analysis, setting, main events, theme, lesson, problem, and solution. They will also be writing summaries as part of this review.

Reading homework is due on Thursday.

## Writing

Students will read and understand a prompt and produce a coherent and edited piece of writing within a specified amount of time.
