Math Review

We are reviewing multiplication fluency. This week, we focused on facts including 0, 1, 2, 10, & 11. Next week, we will continue with 0, 1, 2, 3, 10, & 12. We are using 3 minute drills for practice and assessing on Thursday.

We will continue small groups with rounding and subtraction. Many students are showing academic progress.
